#### NEW ARTS COURSE OFFERED

### Description

A new course in Synergic Arts is now being offered through the Dance Program of the Health, Physical Education, and Recreation Department. The course involves both mutual and exclusive exploration of sound, light, and movement as artistic media. The synergic approach seeks to achieve a unique creative experience collectively, then use that experience to synthesize various artistic forms in new ways. Though offered through the Dance Program, Synergic Arts is designed to appeal to people working in any creative area.

#### Details

Synergic Arts carries full and half course independent study credit, depending on your level of participation. The course will span two semesters and though the fall semester is a pre-requisite, the credit itself will be applied in the Spring. Students will begin working with workshop-type techniques leading to a major performance next February and the presentation of individual student pieces later in the Spring Semester. The first class is this Thursday, September 30, 7:30 P.M., at Baldwin Auditorium on East Campus. Classes will convene every Thursday evening this fall and more frequently as performance time approaches.
